ACM SIGGRAPH Executive Committee (EC) Chair, Eakta Jain

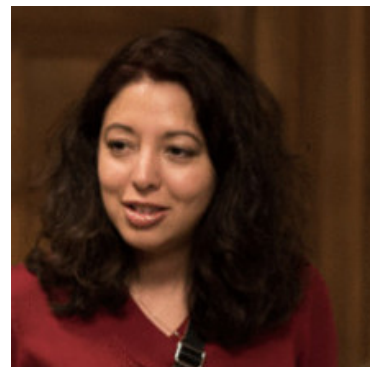
